Letters to the Editor:

A letter to the editor is a message written to share your view on a current issue you feel is important in the community, state, or country. You may also write a letter to the editor in response to a news item. feature, or opinion editorial (op-ed) recently published in The Observer.

Please limit letter submission length to approximately 350 words.

News Tips/Story Suggestions:

If there is a topic, event, or issue that you would like to see The Mount Observer cover, you may provide us with the suggestion.

Please note: submitting a news tip or story suggestion does not **guarantee** that the story will be written by one of our writers.

Article Submissions:

We accept submissions of news articles, opinion editorials (op-eds), media reviews, and essays.

News articles should pertain to the MWCC community in some way. This can include news coverage of an event or student organization. This can also include coverage of

current events on a global or national scale but must be localized back to the MWCC community.

Opinion editorials (op-eds) are opinion essays written with a clear point of view or argument supported by specific evidence. They should take a stance that some but not all of our readers would agree with.

Media reviews are an evaluation or critique of a piece of media content, such as movies, TV shows, books, music, podcasts, or other forms of entertainment.

Please limit submission length to approximately 800 words..

Non-written Submissions:

We accept submissions of photography, graphic design, artwork, comics, and other forms of visual media.

When uploading visual media, please upload your files in the largest size available.

Disclaimers:

Numerous factors affect whether a submission is accepted for publication, including space constraints, timeliness, relevance, and whether or not additional edits are needed. You don't need to have any special journalistic expertise to have your article considered for publication.
